**OPEN BURNING AMENDMENT ORDINANCE
GRAND HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE OPEN BURNING ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 200, AS AMENDED, BY RENUMBERING SECTION 2.5 TO BE SECTION 2.6; BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 2.5; AND BY ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

GRAND HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF OTTAWA, AND STATE OF MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Regulation of Open Burning. Section 2.5 of the Opening Burning Ordinance, Ordinance No. 200, is renumbered to Section 2.6, and Section 2.5 is added to state in its entirety as follows.

5. No person shall cause or permit burning on "Ozone Action!" days, as determined by the appropriate governmental agency which has jurisdiction. The Fire Chief shall be responsible for notifying all public and private campgrounds within the Township whenever an "Ozone Action!" day is declared.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of the Charter Township of Grand Haven, Ottawa County, Michigan, on January 25, 2010, after introduction and a first reading on January 11, 2010, and publication after such first reading as required by Michigan Act 359 of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective on March 2, 2010, which date is 30 days after publication of the Ordinance.
