Grand Haven Charter Township is accepting applications for the following positions:

PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBER – 2 VACANCIES

Planning Commission members are responsible for the zoning ordinance including text amendments and rezoning land; formulating the master plan along with regular reviews and updates; considering land use applications for site plan review, special land use, site condos, and planned unit developments. Members are also responsible for reviewing matters referred by the Township Board.

The Michigan Planning Enabling Act requires members shall be representative of important segments of the community such as economic, governmental, educational, and social development. The Township will give preference to applications identifying experience in the segments currently not represented—natural resources, public health, recreation, education, transportation, and social development.

The Planning Commission meets the first and third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. The position is paid \$74.02 for regular meetings, \$24.67-\$43.19 for special committee meetings, and \$12 per hour for training sessions paid for by the Township
