

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR AN AMENDMENT

“Explore the Grand Region, a Community Parks & Recreation Plan in Northwest Ottawa County, 2015 – 2019”
for the City of Ferrysburg, City of Grand Haven, Grand Haven Charter Township, Spring Lake Township, and
Village of Spring Lake.

The public is invited to offer comment on the proposed amendment to the Grand Haven Charter Township portion of the parks and recreation plan. The public comment period will be open from Monday, November 19, 2018 – December 10, 2018. Comments may be submitted in writing by residents or given publicly at the hearing described below. Draft copies of the plan can be viewed at www.ghc.org, and/or during normal business hours at the Township Hall (13300 168th Avenue).

RESIDENTS OF GRAND HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP and other interested parties, please take notice that the Grand Haven Charter Township Board will hold a public hearing on Monday, December 10, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at the Grand Haven Township Hall, 13300 168th Avenue, Grand Haven, MI 49417. The purpose of the hearing will be to hear any and all comments regarding an amendment to the Parks & Recreation Plan that will add the input obtained during the Hofma Vision for the Hofma Park & Preserve Planting Plan (*Witteveen property*) and the Active Recreation Plan (*Wolfe property*). In addition, shoreline stabilization and new waterfront amenities (*dock and boardwalk*) featuring universal design at Pottawattomie Park is also proposed to be included. Including this amendment in the Parks & Recreation Plan will enable the Township to apply for grant funding during 2019.

Written comments regarding this Amendment to the Parks and Recreation Plan must be received no later than Monday, December 10th. They may be directed to:
