**2002 UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE ORDINANCE  
TOWNSHIP OF GRAND HAVEN, MICHIGAN  
ord. no. 371 eff. Jan. 31, 2003**

An Ordinance to adopt by reference the uniform traffic code for cities, townships, and villages, as amended in 2002, to provide for penalties for the violation of this ordinance, administrative liability, the repeal of conflicting ordinances, and to provide for the effective date of this Ordinance.

THE TOWNSHIP OF GRAND HAVEN, OTTAWA COUNTY, MICHIGAN  
ORDAINS:

**40.0601      Sec. 1            TITLE**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the “Grand Haven Charter Township Uniform Traffic Code Ordinance”.

**40.0602      Sec. 2            CODE ADOPTED**

The Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages as promulgated by the Director of the Michigan Department of State Police, pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, 1969 P.A. 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328 and made effective October 30, 2002, and all future amendments and revisions to the Uniform Traffic Code when they are promulgated and effective in this State are incorporated and adopted by reference.

**40.0603      Sec. 3            REFERENCES AND CODE**

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages to a “governmental unit” shall mean the Grand Haven Charter Township, Ottawa County, Michigan.

**40.0604      Sec. 4            PENALTIES**

The penalties provided by the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages are hereby adopted by reference.

**40.0605      Sec. 5            ADMINISTRATIVE LIABILITY**

No officer, agent, or employee of the Township shall be personally liable for any damages the Township may occur to any person as a result of any act required or permitted in the discharge of duties under and in the enforcement of this Ordinance.

**40.0606            Sec. 6            SEVERABILITY AND CAPTIONS**

This Ordinance and its various sections, subsections, sentences, phrases, and clauses are declared to be severable. If any section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected. Pronouns shall be read as masculine, feminine, or neuter as may be appropriate. Captions appearing at the beginning of any section shall not be deemed a part of this Ordinance and shall have no independent significance.

**40.0607            Sec. 7            REPEAL**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict in whole or in part with any of the provisions of this Ordinance as of its effective date, are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**40.0608            Sec. 8            EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board on January 27, 2003 after introduction and first reading on January 13, 2003, and publication after the first reading as required by Michigan Act 359 of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective on January 31, 2003, which is the day after publication of the Ordinance.
