Grand Haven Charter Township is accepting applications for the following position:

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS – ALTERNATE MEMBER – 2 VACANCIES

The Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA) is predominately responsible for maintaining the integrity of the Zoning Ordinance when reviewing requests to vary from the strict applications of its provisions. Specifically, the ZBA hears and decides appeals from any order, requirement, decision, or determination made by the Zoning Administrator or the Planning Commission. The ZBA may reserve or affirm wholly or partly, or may modify such order, requirement, decision or determination as well as have the power to direct the issuance of a permit. The ZBA is also responsible for interpreting the text of the zoning ordinance and zoning map.

Alternate members attend all ZBA meetings, sit with the regular members, participate in the discussion of the case but are unable to vote on motions. If a regular member is unable to attend a meeting or must be recused due to a conflict of interest—an alternate shall serve in the case until a final decision has been made—by being called to sit as a regular member with the same voting rights. More on the ZBA can be found in Chapter 19 of the Zoning Ordinance.

The ZBA meets the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. This position is paid \$61.70 for regular meetings, \$43.19 for special committee meetings, and \$12 per hour for training sessions paid for by the Township.
